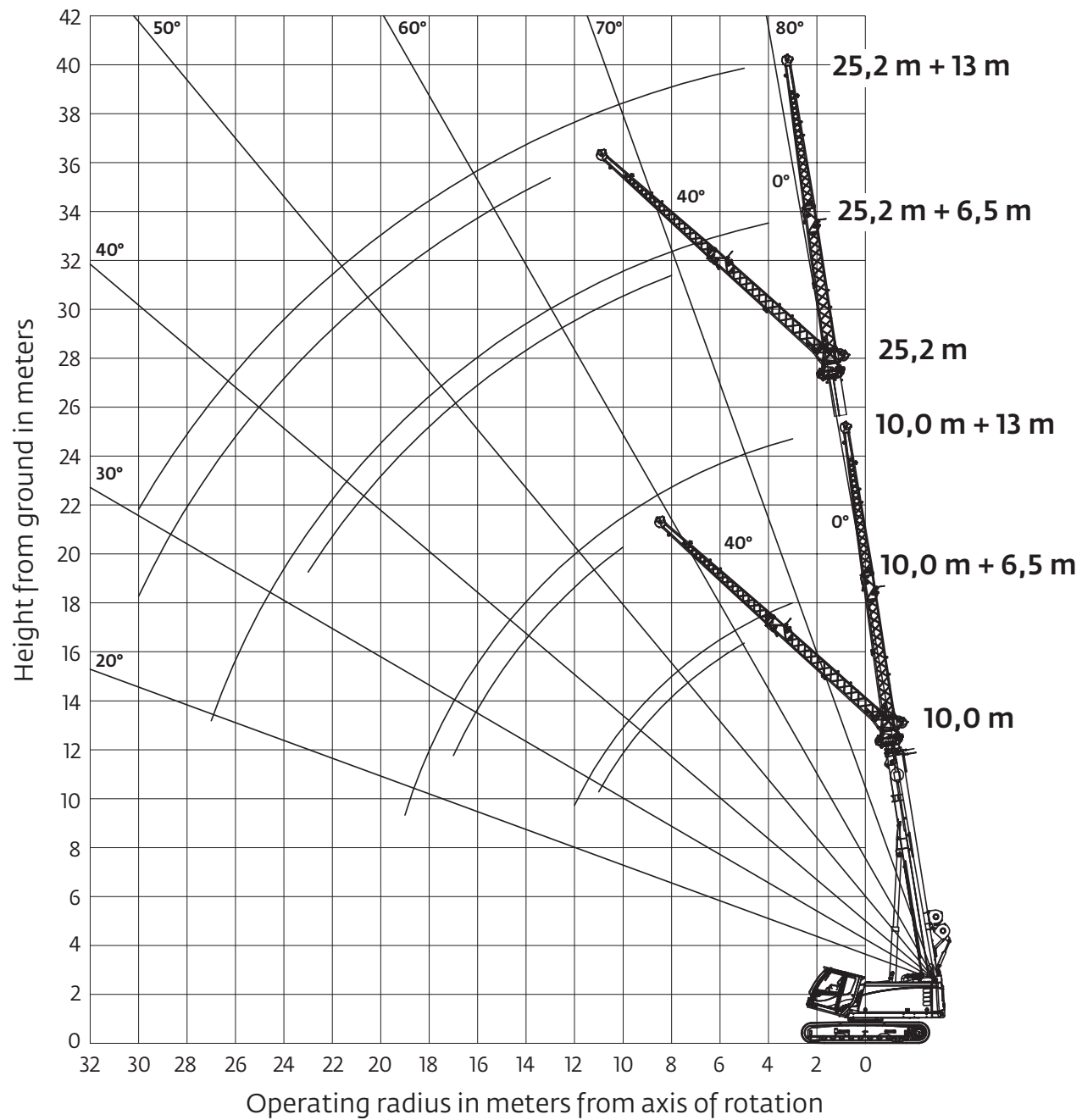

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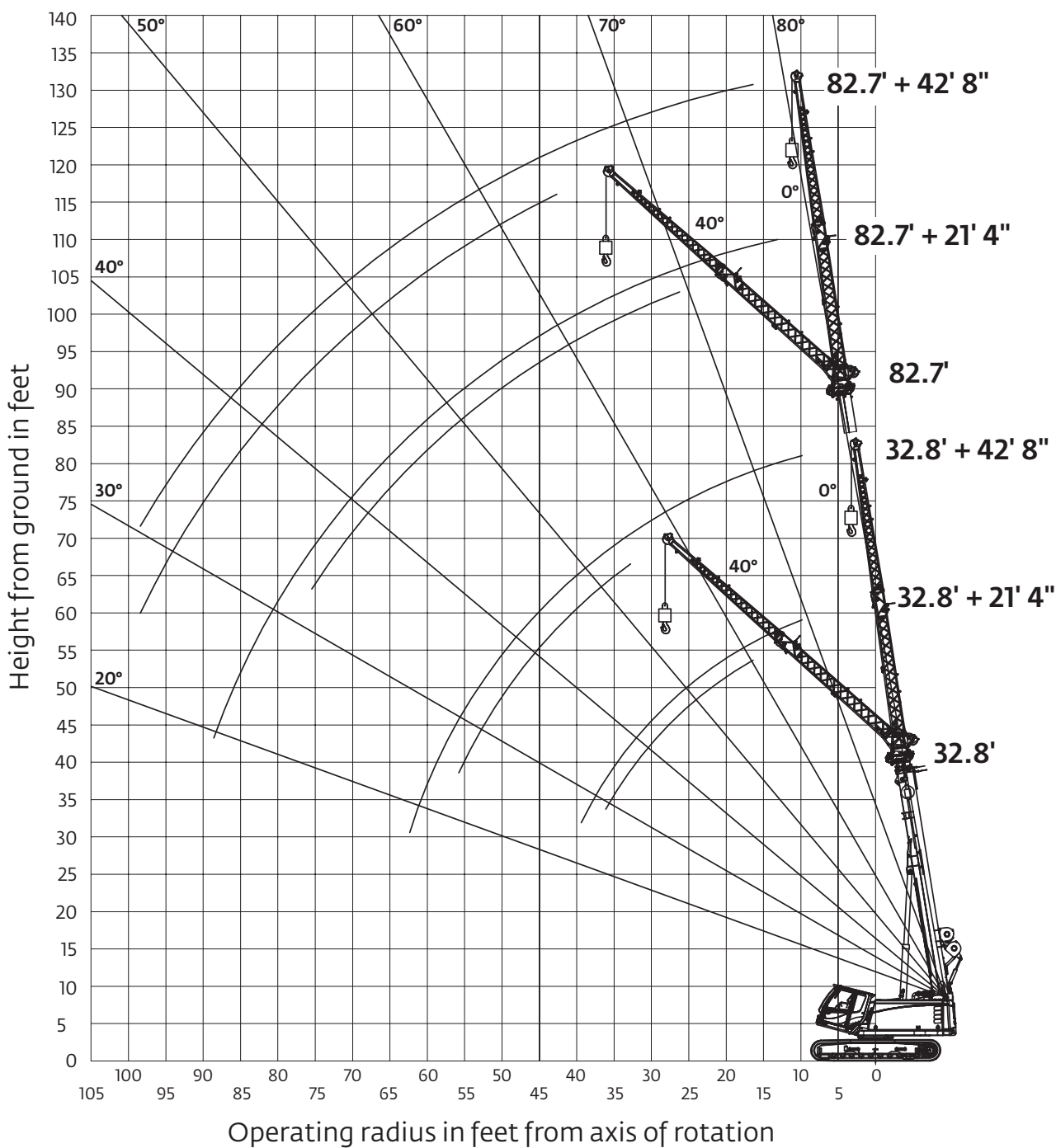

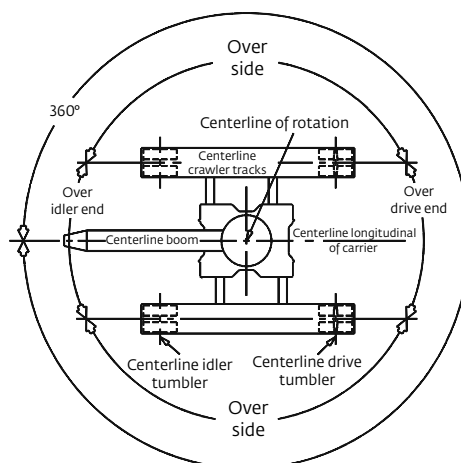

Load moment and independent anti-two block system with audio visual warning and control lever lock-out. These systems provide graphic display of boom angle, length, radius, tip height, relative load moment, maximum permissible load, load indication and warning of impending two-block condition with lock-out hoist function.

5000 kg (11,025 lb) - includes two removable counterweight inserts weighing 400 kg (882 lb) each.



Cab

Large capacity operator's compartment that includes an air suspended operator's seat with lumbar support, heated seat, headrest, 3 inch safety belt, ergonomic control panels, load sensing electric dual axis joystick controls, travel pedals and levers, exceptional sound insulation, split cab door with fold out window, excellent all around visibility, tinted safety glass, front and rear tilt out window, large skylight w/ sun protection, windshield and roof wiper/washer system, radio with USB input and Bluetooth, climate control (A/C, heat and defrost), fire extinguisher, and 15° tilt capability for improved overhead vision and ergonomic posture. Swing
